Ms. Spautz, it has been a significant period since we last spoke. Attached is a follow-up letter the Knightsen Town Community Services District (KTCSD) sent to the East Contra Costa Habitat Conservancy (ECCHC).

I am advising both of you of this letter because in the past the Department of Fish and Wildlife has provided grant support to the proposed Knightsen Wetlands Restoration Project. The KTCSD Board of Directors and members of the Knightsen community continue to have grave concerns about the proposed wetlands project. Our concerns have not been adequately addressed and the ECCHC has not followed through with the additional public outreach they committed to. We continue to be opposed to the proposed project.

We hope that you will take our concerns into account before providing any additional support and/or funding for the proposed Knightsen wetlands.
